



第1天 吉隆坡 🛪 关西

于吉隆坡国际机场集合办理登记手续,然后乘搭班机飞往日本。 [↑] 抵达关西机场后,转运至机场酒店休息。

第2天 关西 - 73公里 - 奈良 - 32公里 - 大阪

- ☆良东大寺: 南都七大寺之一, 也是世界文化遗产。大佛殿内放置约15米高的铜铸大佛像-卢舍那佛, 外面则有梅花鹿群。
- 奈良公园是一座巨大的公园,位于若草山脚下到处都是非常调皮和友善的鹿群。一些鹿已经学习向游客鞠躬请求喂食。

季节安排

奈良县春日大社(4月20日-5月7日)

每年春季都生机勃勃,200多颗紫藤树将会盛开。

- 黑门市场:这里到处香味扑鼻,您可以品尝各式到地小食。正 是能力满满的大阪传统市场。
- ☆新世界: 是大阪其中一个著名美食商区, 战前已蓬勃发展。 立着的通天阁, 其正是大阪新世界的怀旧象征。
- □ 心斋桥: 大阪最繁华的商业街。最著名的百货商店街,流行时尚街,风味小食物餐厅街,还有道顿掘都集中在这里。

第3天 大阪 - 55公里 - 京都 - 222公里 - 滨松

- 🗂 体验日本速度最快的"新干线"子弹火车前往京都市。
- 亡 古典京都: 穿梭"二年坂,三年坂"千年日式风情老街,有时候更可以遇见穿着江户时代和服的日本艺妓。
- 灣清水寺: 不仅是世界文化遗产, 也是京都最古老的寺院, 以及最具人气的观光圣地。四周绿树环抱, 春季时有樱花浪漫, 是赏樱名所之一。秋季时一探红叶狩的魅力。

季节安排

园山公园 (3月16日 - 4月15日)

京都著名的赏樱名所,

最受瞩目的是公园内那颗淡粉红的百年樱花树"枝垂樱"。

伏见稻荷神社 (4月16日-3月15日)

京都最古老的神社之一。

神社内可见许多精雕细刻的狐狸(稻荷神的使者)雕像, 以及让无数人深深爱上这座神社的"千本鸟居"。

第4天 滨松 - 202公里 - 富士山 - 99公里 - 伊豆

- ②野八海: 富士山山水。长达数十年富士山不断的融雪, 渗透而形成的地下泉水。
- 御殿场综合购物广场: 这里拥有多家日本国内外时下最流行,最值得选购的名牌。

季节安排

富士山(4月16日 -11月15日)

如果时间及天气许可的话,您能登上富士山5合目。 富士山是全日本最高山,海拔3776公尺。 走在山上的风景如诗如画,犹如在空中漫步。

富士山河口湖芝樱公园(4月20日-5月20日)

春季时分,富士山下就会呈现壮观的"粉红地毯" 一整片渐层的粉红和富士山的景色,美不胜收。

富士山河口湖香草节(6月20日-7月10日)

初夏时节,河口湖畔的大石公园盛开着美丽的薰衣草。

伊豆温泉:我们将在最闻名且古老的温泉老区过夜。

第5天 伊豆温泉 - 142公里 - 东京

- 修禅寺温泉: 许多主要景点都靠近寺庙。附近有一座竹林, 竹制的传统工艺品也是修禅寺的特产。
- 户田港口: 这里原是静冈县伊豆海岸线上的小渔港,同时也是个很好的打卡热点。
- 灣 浅草寺: 东京最古老的寺庙, 也是必游热门景点。这座寺庙的标志是门前悬挂着的巨大"雷门"大灯笼。
- **简新宿**: 吃喝玩了及购物天堂,还有不夜城之称的歌舞伎町。

DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR X KANSAI AIRPORT

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for departure fliaht to Japan.

Transfer to hotel for rest after arrival Kansai Airport.

DAY 2 KANSAI - 73km - NARA - 32km - OSAKA

- Nara Todaiji Temple: A UNESCO Heritage Site that was constructed in 752 and one of Japan's most and historically significant temples. You may also encounter groups of Nara deer here.
- Nara Park: is a massive park at the foot of Mt. Wakakusa full of very playful and friendly deer. Deer crackers here for sales around the park, and some deer have learned to bow to visitors to ask to be fed.

SEASONAL ARRANGEMENT

Kasuga Taisha Shrine (20 Apr – 07 May)

in Nara Prefecture, every spring season more than 200 wisteria trees are in full blossom.

- Kuromon Market: A traditional marketplace filled with tantalizing scents, foods and pure of Osaka energy.
- Shinseikai "New World": is a district in Osaka that was developed before the war and then neglected in the decades afterwards at the district's centre stands Tsutenkaku Tower, the nostalgia-evoking symbol of Shinseikai.
- Shinsaibashi: Shop at Osaka's busiest and largest shopping area, department store, fashion street, local snacks and Dotombori are all here.

DAY 3 OSAKA - 55km - KYOTO - 222km - HAMAMATSU

- Experience Japan most fastest "Shinkansen" Bullet train ride to Kyoto City
- Classical Kyoto: Walk along"Ninenzaka, "Sannenzaka" a typical Japanese souvenir street that you might spot Geisha walking around the street.
- Kiyomizu Dera Temple: One of the most celebrated temples in Japan and listed in the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy the beautiful view of cherry blossoms in spring and maple leaves in autumn.

SEASONAL ARRANGEMENT

Maruyama Koen (16Mar - 15Apr): The park is known for its beautiful garden and magnificent cherry blossom in spring and maple leaves in autumn.

Fushimi Inari Shrine (16Apr - 15Mar): A shrine dedicated to Inari, the god of rice, sake & prosperity. With dozens of statues of foxes and thousands of vibrant orange "Tori" gates makes it one of the most popular shrines in Japan

DAY 4 Hamamatsu - 202km - Mt. Fuji - 99km - Izu

Underground water from Mt Fuji. It begins with the snow on the top of Mt Fuji. The water travel over decades and finally spring at Oshino Hakkai. Gotemba Premium Outlet: Besides international brand, you can find local Japanese brand as well. From time to time, there will be added value promotion.

SEASONAL ARRANGEMENT

Mt. Fuji (16 Apr - 15 Nov)

If weather permissible, proceed to Mt Fuji 5 station to enjoy the magnificent view of "UNKAI" in Japan's highest mountain.

Fuji Kawaguchiko Shibazakura Park (20 Apr- 20 May) Enjoy splendid view of Shibazakura the "Pink Carpet" with Mt. Fuji in the ground.

Fuji Kawaguchiko Herb Festival (20 Jun - 10 Jul)
In early summer, beautiful purple lavender flowers are in season and flourish at Oishi Park on shores of Lake Kawaguchiko.

Izu Onsen: Overnight in the most famous and oldest onsen hot spring in Shizuoka Prefecture.

DAY 5 IZU ONSEN - 142km - TOKYO

- Izu Onsen: There are bamboo forest and traditional craftworks made from local bamboo.
- Heda Port: Is a small fish village on the Izu Peninsula in Shizuoka
 Prefecture known for its views of Japan east coast.
- Asakusa Temple: Oldest Buddhist temple and a Must visit in Tokyo. The hallmark of this temple is the huge red lantern with Thunder Gate carved on it.
- There're no questions that Tokyo is an ultimate shopper's paradise and Shinjuku is one of the best retails hubs.

DAY 6 TOKYO - 22km - HANEDA AIRPORT

- Tokyo is expensive, but in **Ueno Ameyoko**, you can find bargains on almost everything. This makes for plenty of lively interactions not typical of most retails in Japan.
- Free & leisure until we transferred to Tokyo International Airport.
